STATUTE RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PLATINUM JUBILEE CHAIR FOR SWAMY VIVEKANANDA STUDIES IN THE UNIVERSITY, FRAMED UNDER SECTION 15(1) OF THE KARNATAKA STATE UNIVERSITIES ACT, 1976.

I TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT.

- 1) The Statute shall be called " Statute relating to the establishment of Platinum Jubilee Chair for Swamy Vivekananda Studies ".
- 2) The Statute shall come into effect from the date of assent of the Chancellor.

II LOCATION.

The Chair shall be located in the Department of Studies in Philosophy, Manasagangothri, Mysore.

III OBJECTS.

- 1) The object of the Chair is to have an indepth study of literature of Swamy Vivekananda.
- 2) The impact of the literature of Swamy Vivekananda on the different religions.
- 3) Co-ordination of different religion on the basis of the literature of Swamy Vivekananda.
- 4) Comparative study of Swamy Vivekananda thoughts, lectures in India and abroad, with the present social order of the Society.
- 5) Publication of Swamy Vivekananda literature, thoughts and lectures etc.,

IV (A) Visiting Professors

- 1) There shall be a Visiting Professor/Scholar who shall be appointed on invitation by the Syndicate for a period not less than 6 months and not exceeding one academic year.
- 2) Visiting Professor shall be selected from amongst eminent Scholars in the Field of Philosophy and Scholars from Ramakrishna Missions in India and abroad.
- 3) The eminent personalities who may be able to deliver lectures on different religions.
- 4) Houd Saints, Spirituals who have done considerable works in that field may be considered as Visiting Professor to this Chair.
- 5) Visiting Professor, Scholar shall be eligible for an honorarium of Rs.8,000/- per month and free accommodation in the University Guest House, Manasagangothri, Mysore. In case of In-service Professors/Scholars his/her total emoluments will be protected.
- 6) A Contingency Crapt of Rs.15,000/- will be provided for the Visiting Professor, Scholar.



V SCOPE.

- 1) Holding lectures not less than 4 in a month by the Visiting Professor/Scholar on the objects stipulated in the Statute.
- 2) To give attention on the other items of the objectives during the rest of the period.
- 3) Conducting Seminars, Workshops, Study Circles to formulate the objectives of the Statutes

VI FINANCE:

- 1) The Expenditure may be met out from the funds collected to the Platinum Jubilee Celebrations of the University. Studies in
- 2) The Department of/Philosophy will take up the follow up works of the Chair as per objectives of the Statutes for its effective implementation.
