



Establishment of the Centre for Rajarshi Nalvadi Krishnaraja Wodeyar's Social and Development Studies - framing of statutes thereof -reg

Preamble:

The State Government has sanctioned a grant of Rs. 500 lakhs to institute the above centre.

It is needless to highlight the welfare policies undertaken by Nalvadi Krishnaraja Wodeyar for the people of Mysuru. Though he had to work under British, the developmental projects and people centric welfare polices placed Mysuru in the forefront of development compared to other native States.

The Pro-People policies introduced by him particularly, English education provided an intrinsic strength and enabled many disadvantageous communities to being a step towards mobility. It was revolution and historic decision in providing 50% of Government jobs for Backward Classes. The Mysuru was the first State in South India which had provided social justice.

Not only major programs initiated in the fields of agriculture, irrigation industry, commerce, literature, cultural spheres and facilities extended to Backward Classes including Women and Dalits to have education. Through these programmes, Nalvadi Krishnaraja Wodeyar emerged as revered morning star in South India, a Champion and harbinger as social justice. Sir M. Visveshvarayya, the Dewan under him earned 'Bhartaratna' in the post-independence days, because of the programmes he initiated as the Chief Engineer and Dewan under the patronage of Nalvadi Krishnaraj Wodeyar, all of which would speak for his achievements.

Mahatma Gandhi who closely watched the pro-people welfare activities of the maharaja remarked that "this is my dream Ramarajya" referring to Mysuru and respectably called Nalvadi as "Rajarshi"

Having regard to the historical achievements seen in the regime of Nalvadi Krishnaraja Wodeyar, the University of Mysore has proposed to bring awareness among people in various field by undertaking printing and publishing the speeches of Nalvadi, his letters, writings etc. For the systematic studies in this behalf, the University has proposed to establish the above Centre.

IN EXERCISE OF POWERS CONFERRED UNDER SEC. 40(F), (i) READ WITH SEC. 29 (2)(T) AND 41 OF KARNATAKA STATE UNIVERSITIES ACT, 2000. THE

SYNDICATE FRAMES THE FOLLOWING STATUTES

I. TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT:

These Statutes shall be called, "The University of Mysore (Institution of Rajarshi Nalvadi Krishnaraja Wodeyar's Social and Development Studies Centre)" Statutes, 2015

These Statutes shall come into force from the date they are assented to by the Chancellor.

II. AIMS AND PROGRAMMES:

The Proposed Nalvadi Krishnaraja Wodeyar Social and Development Centre in the Department of History under takes projects to study and understand the socio-cultural and economic development achieved during Nalvadi's time and keeping them as foundation for today's development activities in Karnataka.

Under the guidance of Nalvadi Krishnaraja Woderyar's developmental & Social Justice oriented policies, the proposed Centre guide the projects that could be undertaken to empower the caste and communities which have remained marginalized and under-developed even to this day.

A comparative study of the conditions prevailed in Mysuru and other States which were under the British Provinces will be undertaken. Fellowships will be given to eligible candidates who undertake the study of these aspects.

To bring awareness among the people on the achievement, social development during the rule of Nalvadi Krishnaraja Wodeyar, it is proposed to ensue motivation for undertaking new projects of development on the above lines.

It would also be one of the activities to recognize and honour the seniors and juniors who have been contributing to the social development, on annual basis.



3. Senior fellowship every year 1 Candidate
4. Post-Doctoral Degree-Every Year 1 Candidate
5. Senior Fellowship- Every Year 2 Candidates (each 1.80 lakh)
6. Junior Fellowship- Every Year 2 Candidates (each selected scholars 1.44 lakh)
7. Tour Programmes of selected scholars visiting neighbor State for Comparative Study (three, ten days tours, each year)
8. Translations
9. Workshops and Seminars for Scholars
10. Special Lectures for Students in Selected Colleges
11. Arranging Competitions, Debates, Essay writing, Songs and Drama and Performance Arts for youths in all districts
12. Preparation of Audio CD, Broadcasting containing the Songs, Drama Documentary film in consonance with the ideology of the centre
13. Prizes to encourage elders and youths
14. Publishing of Books
