

Preamble

This BoS appreciate the honesty and enthusiasm of Kannada Academy, USA, that intended to teach "SAVI Kannada" for candidates in the USA and across the world.

By considering this as special circumstance, the UoM has extended moral support to the Kannada Academy, USA, which is propagating the Kannada language and culture across the globe. In this regard, the UoM has given affiliation for the special certificate courses with syllabus.

Certificate Courses

The BoS has approved for 2 certificate courses, namely: -

- 1) Basic Kannada Certificate Course [BKCC] duration 1 year, consisting of two semesters, total 16 credits.
- 2) Advanced Kannada Certificate Course [AKCC] duration 2 years, consisting of four semesters, total 32 credits.

The BoS has provided options for candidates to either complete the study for one year for BKCC or complete the study for two years for AKCC. Direct enrollment to AKCC without completing the BKCC is not allowed.

The BoS has approved to formulate the syllabus of AKCC later.

Syllabus of BKCC:

Semester-1

Paper – I (Swaraballa-1): Numbers, colors, relationships, body, plants, animals, pronouns, common nouns, verbs, adjectives, 3rd person neuter present tense, short vowel letters and symbols, consonant letters and subscripts and blends.

Paper – II (Swaraballa-2): Numbers, colors, relationships, body, plants, animals, pronouns, nouns, verbs, adjectives, 3rd person neuter past & future tense, long vowel letters and symbols, special vowels and symbols, consonant letters and subscripts and blends.

Semester-II

Paper - III (Aksharaballa-1: Numbers, colors, relationships, body, plants, animals, pronouns, nouns, verbs, adjectives, 1st and 2nd person tenses. Consonant letters, their subscripts, and blends.

Paper – IV (Aksharaballa-2): Numbers, relationships, body, plants, animals, adverbs, adjectives, 3rd person human tense. Consonants, aspirate Consonants letters, their subscripts and Diphthongs and blends.

Textbooks:

The BoS has approved the textbooks developed by Shiva Gowder of USA and published by "Kannada Development Authority, Government of Karnataka, Bengaluru, as textbooks to this course.

The BoS has approved following books as reference books for the course:

Qualification of Teachers

BoS has approved for teachers qualification as below: -

- 1. A teacher must be graduated from recognized university in India or USA.
- 2. A teacher must have undergone at the minimum Kannada as first language in their matriculation.

The BoS has also approved that, the faculties of University of Mysore, Mysuru, shall deliver special lectures through online mode.

Composition of Board of Examiners

The BoS has approved the composition of BoE as provided in separate sheet. The BoE is responsible for question paper setting and evaluation.

Marks and Examination Patterns

The BoS has approved for following marks and examination patterns –

- a) The course, its examination and evaluation shall be online as well as offline mode.
- b) As per the CBCS of the UoM, each paper of the course shall have C-1, C-2 & C3 patterns of examination and marks:

C1 & C2 are for internal assessment

C3 is for Final assessment

C-1 -15 marks for internal Assignment

C-2 -15 marks for internal Test

C-3 - 70 marks for final examination

Question paper pattern:

As per the BoS approval, the question paper of each paper shall have following pattern -

- a) 10 MCQs for total 10 marks, one mark for each question.
- b) 5 match the following type question 5 marks

- c) 5 fill in the gap type question 5 marks
 - d) One sentence answer 10 questions 20 marks 2 marks for each question.
 - e) Write at least 5 sentences by seeing pictures or images; total 2 pictures 5 marks for each picture 10 marks.
 - f) Oral examination shall be for 20 marks.

Evaluation Pattern:

The BoS has approved for the following evaluation pattern :-

- a) Teachers of the KA, USA shall work as invigilators.
- b) Evaluation of C3 should be completed within 15 days.
- c) C1, C2, & C3 marks list shall be submitted to the UoM within 5 days after the completion of C3 evaluation.
- d) The UoM will announce results and issue certificates to only those candidates who successfully complete the course.
- e) Up to 2 supplementary examinations will be provided to those candidates, who will be either absent for the examination or failed in the examination.
- f) Photocopy of the answer scripts shall be provided to candidates based on their request and upon paying requisite fee as per the UoM rules.
- g) Candidates shall apply for re-evaluation withing 10 days after the announcement of result by paying requisite fee as per the UoM rules.
- h) Examination related documents should be protected by the KA, USA, for minimum 3 years.

On the topics such as, - student's attendance, passing criteria, make up exam, grading and percentage, grievance cell and any other topics are subjected to the CBCS regulations of the UoM, Mysuru.
