Inter-Collegiate Cultural competitions held on 15<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> October 2014



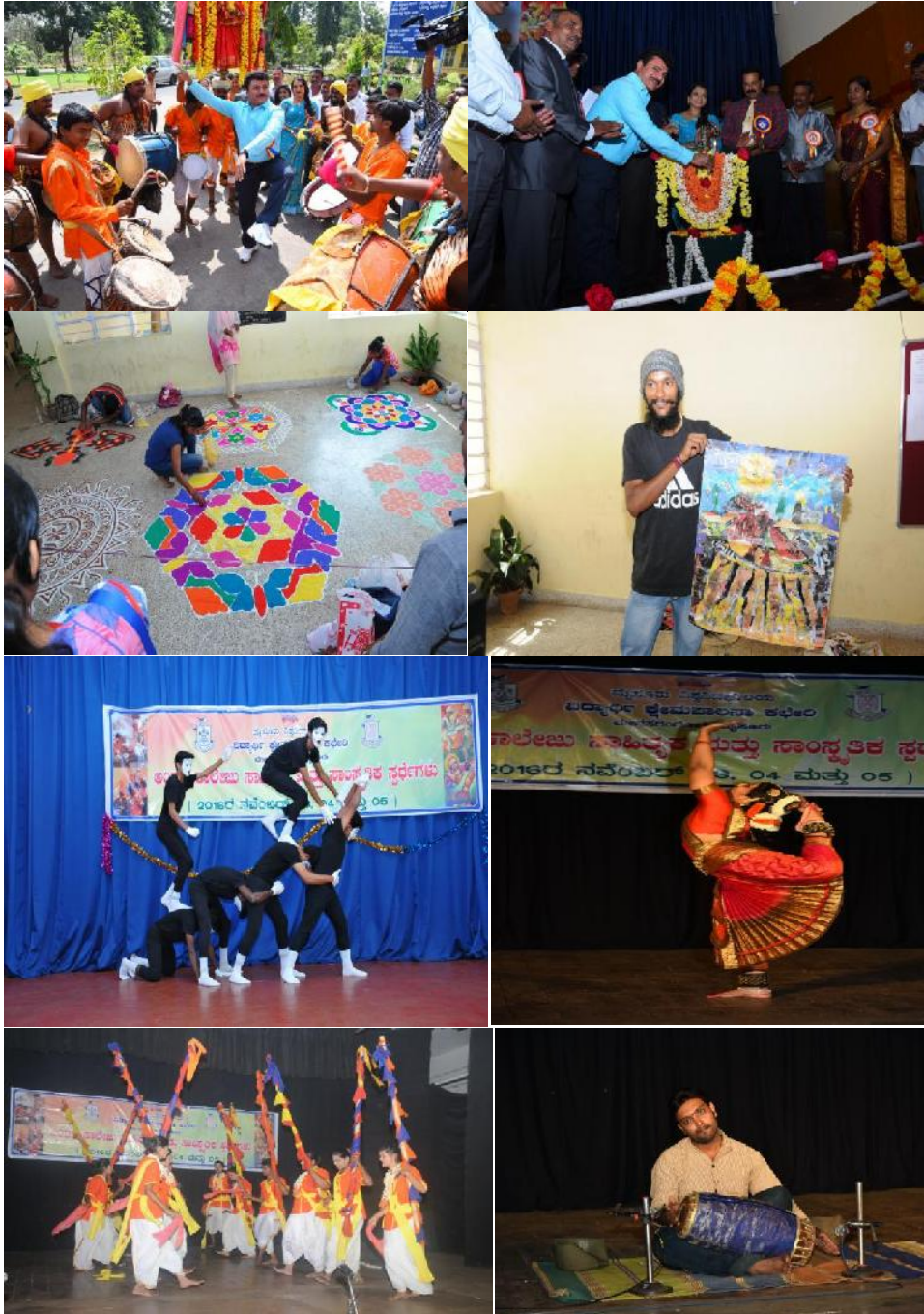
