REPORT OF ACTIVITIES FOR THE YEAR 2016-17(Progress Report)

The Empanelled Training institution for Karnataka is one of the important training institutions imparted by the ministry of youth affairs and sports, Govt. of India across the country.

The University of Mysore has been associating with the Ministry for the purpose of training of NSS Programme Officers since 1992. We are catering to the training needs of NSS functionaries of 31 Universities and 4 Directorates in the State of Karnataka. More than 4000 Programme Officers have been trained by this Centre so far. We are happy to state that we could strengthen the National Service Scheme activities in the State through intensive training and field exposure to the NSS Programme Officer trainees. The team work of NSS Regional Directorate, State NSS Office, NSS ETI, Programme Co-ordinators of all Universities and Directorates, Programme Officers and Volunteers in the State yielded good results and our University could bag the prestigious **Indira Gandhi National NSS Award** for the year 2015-2016.

A brief account of training achievements of the ETI for the year 2016-2017 is given below;

ETI Advisory committee meeting:

In order to assess the training requirements of each University /Directorate, a meeting of ETI Advisory Committee was convened on 21st April 2016. The meeting was chaired by Prof.K.S.Rangappa the honourable vice chancellor of the University of Mysore. All the Key Functionaries of NSS in the State including NSS Regional Director and State NSS Officer attended the meeting. The ETI Advisory Committee decided to organize 20 Training programmes during the year 2016-2017 taking to account the total number of untrained Programme Officers in each University / Directorate.

Training programmes and officers trained:

Fifteen training programmes have been organised out of twenty programmes sanctioned to the ETI during 2016-17 and trained around **504 programme officers** of **31 Universities and 4 directorates** across the state. The training session of this year began in the month of May 2016 and the last batch of the training was held in the month of February 2017.

The Programme Co-ordinators in the Universities / Directorates were asked to depute Programme Officers in each Course according to a quota fixed for the purpose considering the total number of untrained Programme Officers in each University / Directorate. We are happy to state that the Programme Co-ordinators could ensure the maximum participation of their untrained Programme Officers in all batches except a few. The participation of female programme officers in the training programme is 16 per cent.

Training module and details of resource persons:

The Training Module that we follow is very similar to the Module sent by the Ministry. Moreover, the rich experience of university of Mysore in working with individuals, groups and communities strengthen the training components and give emulating working models to the Programme Officer trainees. The new areas like **Social networking, counselling** for NSS functionaries etc; were also added to the Training Module this year. The one day field programme in each course helped the trainees to enhance their planning and organizing skills especially in working with the people in rural settings.

The thematic sessions on core areas of NSS and other specific topics were presented by subject experts and other Resource Persons who have rich experience in the field of National Service Scheme.
