

Chairman welcomed all the members of the board and placed the agenda of the meeting. After a depth review, it was unanimously resolved as follows:

1. Minor modification in the Regulations Governing the BCA -Hons(CYber Security of Data Science)

The current academic regulations and syllabus were reviewed. Members acknowledged the need to relax the regulation 23SBCA2.2 which states that "the candidates shall have secured a minimum of 50 % of marks in aggregate in the qualifying examination. Provided that candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and any other groups classified by the Government of Karnataka for such purpose from time to time shall be considered eligible for admission, if they have passed the qualifying examination giving eligibility for the admission with 45 % of marks in aggregate." to enhance accessibility and flexibility for students while maintaining academic standards.

The proposed change to relax the regulation 23SBCA2.2 was put to vote and unanimously approved by all members present.

2. Panel of Examiners:

Panel of examiners for the academic year 2024 -2025 have been prepared and approved by the BoS members.

The meeting concluded with the Chairperson thanking all members for their participation and valuable inputs.
