Proceedings of the BOS (CB) Meeting held on February 4th 2023

1. The Hon'ble members of the BOS have finalised the list of examiners by adding the names of the newly eligible faculty and by deleting the retired teachers of all the universities in Karnataka State.
2. The Board has decided to make no changes in the present PG syllabus for Economics and Co-operation (PG).
3. Since, no new courses are being introduced during 2023-24 the Board decided to continue the same.
4. The Board of Studies 2022-23 is a Composite Board having both PG and UG teachers as members .But this Board is having only two UG teachers as its members. Understanding the relevance of NEP for UG, the Board decided to request the university authorities to increase the numbers of UG teachers in the Board by two and also to give one representation to Co-operative Management by adding one faculty from Co-operative management (UG).
5. Since, there is a need to give vocational training to those students who exit after one year of graduation the Board decided to request university to make provision to invite industry related people as special invitees/members to the Board.
6. Since there is a concern among UG teachers about having mathematics and Statistics papers as DSC in third and fourth semester which probably is one of the reasons for students not making Economics their core choice, the Board decided to take the approval of the university to give an option to the students for Mathematics and Statistics papers.

7. Taking into consideration the request of the UG teachers, the advice given by Prof, B. Thimmaegowda regarding this, and keeping Economics BOS(UG), Bengaluru North University, decision regarding this as a precedence, the Board unanimously opined that the papers DSC 3.2 and DSC 4.2 , should be given a choice so that the students can have an option to mathematical papers.

After deliberations, it was decided to give option as follows

3.2.1-Mathematics for Economics or

3.2.2-Factor Pricing and Welfare Economics

4.2.1 Statistics for Economics or

4.2.2 Monetary Economics

8. The Board also agreed to incorporate needed corrections to all the first four semesters' syllabus as per the requirements and the same should be submitted to University for the approval.

9. The members have decided to change the eligibility for the admission of MA Economics by changing the existing eligibility criteria. Accordingly students who have passed B.Sc Economics, B.Com, BCA BBM, BBA, B.Sc with Statistics, B.Sc with Mathematics and B.Sc with Physics are also eligible to apply for the subject Economics after successfully clearing entrance examination in Economics. Earlier it was considered only BA students with Economics as the cognate subject are eligible to apply for MA in Economics. This will help many students to get an opportunity to study the subject Economics.
