Pursuant to the approval of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Ms.Shobha.S, D/o Suresha Nayaka, # 2237, Attimareda Street, Kalkunike, Hunsur Town, Mysuru District is awarded the UGC-JRF in **Chemical Sciences** on a Fellowship value of **Rs.31,000/-** per month initially for a period of two years. She shall work on the research topic "**Cyclo addition of azomethyene Yilds via C-H functionalization and synthetic application of Oxo-dithioester**" under the guidance of Dr.K.Mantelingu, Associate Professor, Department of Studies in Chemistry, Manasagangothri, University of Mysore, Mysuru.

She is entitled to get an Annual Contingency Grant of **Rs.12,000/-** as per rules in force. She shall utilize this grant with the prior permission from the Chairman, Department of Studies in Chemistry, University of Mysore, Mysuru and also on the recommendation of the guide seeking permission for the subsequent occasion. Further, as per rules, she is entitled to draw House Rent Allowance at the rate of **16%** of the fellowship amount. She should report herself for duty to the Chairman, Department of Studies in Chemistry, University of Mysore, Mysuru within a period of one week from the date of receipt of this order, failing which the award will be treated as cancelled.

The tenure of fellowship is initially for two years under the JRF scheme. Upon expiry of this period; the work of the fellow will be evaluated by experts. If the research work is found satisfactory, her tenure will be extended for a further period of three years under the enhanced emoluments of the Senior Research Fellowship (SRF).

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In case, the work for the first two years is not found satisfactory, an additional year will be given to him for improvement. However, during this period she will be designated as a Junior Research Fellow. In such case work will be evaluated again after three years, and if improvement is found, the Fellow will get two more years under the SRF. Thus, the total period of fellowship (JRF and SRF) is five years, and there will be no further provision for extension.

The fellowship will be effective from **07-03-2020** or date of Joining of Ph.D research whichever is later. She should give a declaration at the time of reporting to duty and the same shall be forwarded to the University.

At the time of joining duty, she is required to produce all the Original Certificates of qualifications, age and date of birth before the Chairman, Department of Studies in Chemistry, University of Mysore, Mysuru.

Award of this UGC Junior Research Fellowship is subject to the conditions stipulated in the Comprehensive Ordinance and UGC Guidelines issued from time to time for award of the Research Fellowship. Regarding uploading the documents related to the payment of fellowship, she is directed to approach the ICD Office, Department of Studies in Computer Science, Manasagangothri, University of Mysore, Mysuru.



1. The Admit Card is provisional, subject to the eligibility conditions given in the Information Bulletin.

 - Passport size photograph (same as uploaded with the Online Application Form) to be pasted on the attendance sheet at the Centre.
 - Any one of the original and valid Photo Identification Proof issued by the government – PAN card/ Driving License/ Voter ID/ Passport/ Aadhaar Card (With photograph)/E- Aadhaar/Ration Card.
 - PwD certificate issued by the Competent Authority, if claiming relaxation under PwD category.
 - **Note:** No Candidate would be allowed to enter the Examination Centre, without identity verification.
4. Candidates are NOT allowed to carry any personal belongings including electronic devices, mobile phone and other materials listed in the Information Bulletin, to the Examination Centre.
