I am writing in support of Dr. R. Suresh's application. I have worked with Dr. Suresh during the summers of 2018 and 2019 and I can testify to his expertise both in Sanskrit and its English translation.

I am an American research-scholar who am presently part of a team working on a multi-volume translation project supported and funded by the Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts (MOU dated 24.10.2017). Together with Drs. Pierre-Sylvain Filliozat and Vasundhara Filliozat, we will publish the critical text and English translation of the *Pampāmāhātmya*, the medieval *sthala purāṇa* for Pampā-kṣetra in present day Hampi, Karnataka. This is an enormous text comprising 173 *adhyāya*-s as contained in five sources.

Last year, I enlisted the help of Dr. Suresh for assistance to review about a dozen of my translated *adhyāya*-s and to consult with him regarding troublesome passages. Dr. Suresh is a rare find in his ability to straddle the worlds both of Sanskrit and of English, which has made him an ideal resource for translation consultation.
