Dear Sir,

The IQAC is pleased to place before you the report of the student feedback survey for the years 2020–21 and 2021–22. This annual survey report depicts the opinions and impressions of students about the University, departments, and fulltime teaching faculty. The survey also shows the students' immediate aspirations and future endeavours.

I am also happy to inform you that the student feedback survey was conducted online for the first time. The earlier data collection instrument was redesigned and updated to suit present-day requirements. A challenge for fair and objective data collection was to maintain the objectivity, confidentiality and privacy while collecting the students' opinions. To ensure and elicit the students' opinion without any fear or favour, no person from the department, including the chairperson, was allowed to be at the venue during data collection. A well-trained three-batch team of IQAC staff completed the assignment of data collection by visiting all the departments. The students were assured of the confidentiality of the data beforehand.

The students answered thirty-two questions. The students were asked to fill in the questionnaire using their smartphone devices. Each student took on an average 20 to 25 min to complete the questionnaire.

One-thousand nine-hundred and eighty-six final semester students from of the University campuses participated in the survey. It has been the vogue to collect the data from the fourth-semester students only as they would have a fair amount of experience and knowledge about the university, department and faculty members, thus making the survey results more meaningful. Opinions on each of the 230 fulltime faculty members were collected from their respective students. This mammoth data collection task was conducted with meticulous planning and surgical precision. This time the report was generated using the expertise available in the University unlike previous years.

The data collected through Google Form has been consolidated and reported in the form of column charts in the report of 1208 pages.

The report is submitted to your good office to follow up on necessary actions. You may consider placing the report before the concerned university bodies. You may also arrange to hand over the respective feedback results through IQAC to the teachers individually, as was done in previous years.
