I am pleased to inform you that based on your qualifying for Eligibility for Assistant Professor in the **June, 2020 Joint CSIR-UGC Test**, you have been selected for award of fellowship under the scheme of 'National Fellowship for Scheduled Caste Students' for the year 2020-21.

The tenure of the Fellowship is five years and it commences from the date of declaration of result of Joint CSIR-UGC Test, i.e., **04.02.2021** (or) from the date of admission under M.Phil./Ph.D. (or) from the date of joining M.Phil./Ph.D. programme, whichever is later.

The candidate is required to get admission and registration for regular and full time M.Phil./Ph.D. course in a University/Institution recognized by UGC at the first available opportunity but not later than three years from the date of issue of this award letter. University/Institution is requested to process for award of fellowship based upon this letter, in accordance with the Guidelines of scheme and Notification dated **11.06.2021**. It may be noted that the fellowship amount shall be disbursed through Canara Bank to bank account of the awardee (any bank) directly. UGC has developed a dedicated web portal (<https://scholarship.canarabank.in>) for capturing data of the awardee. The Universities/Institutions will link the data of the awardee with the master data on the UGC web portal with unique Maker and Checker IDs which have already been provided to them along with the passwords. The Universities/Institutions shall update the information on the master data (regarding monthly payment confirmation, HRA, up-gradation, resignation etc.) of the beneficiaries on monthly basis. Based on the data updated on UGC web portal by the concerned Universities/Institutions, the payment of the fellowship will be made to the beneficiaries (Detailed process available at https://www.ugc.ac.in/ugc_notices.aspx?id=2153).

The e-Certificate of Eligibility for Assistant Professor has already been uploaded on <https://ecertificate.nta.ac.in>. The eligibility of the candidate for availing the fellowship is to be ensured by the University/Institution.

Pursuant to the approval of the Vice-Chancellor, Ms. Suhasini D/o Siddarameshwara, # 578, 5th Cross, 2nd Stage, Bogadi, Mysore -570 026, Karnataka, is awarded the National Fellowship for SC Candidate (UGC- CSIR Test) for the year 2020-21 in Life Science. The National Fellowship for SC is tenable for five years subject to the satisfactory progress report of the fellow. She is eligible to draw Rs. 31,000/- per month for first two years and Rs. 35,000/- per month for next three years. She shall work on the research topic "REPRODUCTIVE PHYSIOLOGY OF POLYCYSTIC SYNDROME IN RATS" under the guidance of Prof. M. Bhagya, Professor, DOS in Zoology, Manasagangotri, Mysuru.

She is entitled to an Annual Contingency Grant of Rs. 12,000/- per annum for initial two years and Rs. 25,000/- per annum for remaining three years as per rules in force. She shall utilize the grant with the prior permission from the Chairman, DOS in Zoology, Manasagangotri, Mysuru and also on the recommendation of the guide on each occasion and she shall furnish the details of amounts drawn during previous occasions while seeking permission for the subsequent occasion. Further as per rules she entitled to draw House Rent Allowance at the rate of 16% of the fellowship amount.

She should report herself for duty to the Chairman, DOS in Zoology, Manasagangotri, Mysuru within a period of one week from the date of receipt of this order, failing which the award will be treated as cancelled and disposed of otherwise. The fellowship will be effect from 04.02.2021 or the date of joining whichever is later.


