## Report of Field visit and workshop organized at Halebidu on 15-02-2021.

A day-long field visit cum workshop at Halebidu was organized by the Department of Studies in Ancient History and Archaeology (University of Mysore) at the excavation site of Halebidu for the students (both MA and Ph.D.) of the department in association with the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI), Bengaluru circle, Bengaluru. A total of 26 students and two temporary staff (Curator and Antiquity Assistant) participated in this program.

At Halebidu, in the premises of Parshwanatha-Shantinatha basadi complex, excavations were undertaken by the Archaeological Survey of India, Bengaluru circle, with a view to clearing the debris accumulated over the ruins of another basadi of the Hoysala period. The objective of the field visit cum workshop was to introduce the students to the method and process of archaeological excavation on the one hand and to familiarize them with the architectural features of the Hoysala temples and basadis. It was also hoped to provide a platform for the students to interact with the archaeologists of the ASI.

Upon reaching the excavation site, Dr. Shivakant Bajapai, Superintending archaeologist, ASI, Bengaluru, welcomed our team and gave a general introduction to the aims and methods of archaeology. The students were then taken around the area of excavation. Thereafter, the students were divided in two batches; while one batch attended the practical session, the other batch was engaged in theory sessions and vice-versa. In the practical session, Shri Murali Mohan (Surveyor, ASI, Bengaluru circle) demonstrated to the students the process of laying trench grids. Shri Guru Bagi (Asst. Superintending Archaeologist, ASI, Srirangapatna) explained the different stages of documentation of artefacts and features exposed during the excavation and showed how different measurements are taken while documenting the context of the archaeological remains. Shri Basavaraju Mayachari (Photographer, ASI, Bengaluru) familiarized the students with the special techniques of photography in archaeological excavations. The students were then allowed to repeat these exercises independently in small groups. In the theory session, Dr. R.N. Kumaran (Assistant Archaeologist, ASI, Bengaluru circle) taught the students about the methods of exploring archaeological sites in addition to the various types of excavation. In addition, he explained the importance of maintaining a pottery yard in excavation. Post-lunch, the students visited the Hoysaleshwara temple at Halebidu where they learnt about the basic features of Hoysala architecture. From there they proceeded back to the excavation camp and saw the important antiquities unearthed in the excavation. Finally, the students were given first-hand experience of digging archaeological layers. Dr. V. Shobha, assistant professor of DOS in Ancient History and Archaeology proposed the vote of thanks.
