Submission guidelines: Abstract should include introduction, method, results, conclusion, and implications in brief with 4-5 Keywords. Follow APA 7th Edition format. Font: Times New Roman, size: 12, Word limit: 300 words. Best paper award will be given in each scientific session.

Selected papers will be published in peer reviewed Journal or edited ISBN book later.

Poster Presentations

Use a clear, concise title with authors' names and affiliations. Font: Times New Roman, word limit: 400-500 words, organize sections: Brief Introduction, Method, Visual Representation of Results, Discussion, Conclusion, Implications and References (5-10 references in APA format).

Incorporate high-quality visuals, a professional colour scheme and prioritize readability

Pre-conference Workshop 1 : Basic Skills in School Counseling by Mr. Sumit Dutta Psychologist, Counsellor & Mental Health Trainer, School Counsellor, Thailand



Mental health is vital but often misunderstood due to myths and taboos. Basic Skills in Counseling (BSiC) helps raise awareness, especially post-COVID. By focusing on personal counseling, BSiC empowers individuals to address their own issues, promoting well-being and enabling greater involvement in academia, activism, and advocacy in mental health. This approach fosters a stronger, healthier society overall.

Pre-conference Workshop 2 : Grief Therapy by Mr. Dinakaran P, Clinical Psychologist, Vistara Foundation, Chennai



Grief is a universal experience, but it varies for each person and situation. There's no set timeline or blueprint for processing loss. Factors such as the nature of the death can influence how someone grieves. Resolving grief is crucial for emotional well-being. In this workshop, Mr. Dinakaran, an experienced RCI registered clinical psychologist, will share his expertise in treating grief, offering valuable insights for participants.

Pre-conference Workshop 3 : Psychotraumatology & EMDR Therapy by Dr. Shyam H. R. & Ms Nithya H M



Approach to treat trauma in various psychological disorders is necessary for Emotional Wellness. EMDR is like a gentler reset button for your brain's traumatic memories. Using bilateral stimulation (typically side-to-side eye movements), this therapy helps your brain reprocess difficult experiences, transforming how traumatic memories are stored. This workshop will introduce participants to Traumatology and EMDR.

EMDR is a psychotherapy designed to resolve symptoms from unresolved life experiences. It uses a structured approach to address past, present, and future trauma, integrating elements of various psychological therapies. EMDR is effective for both children and adults, treating behavioural, emotional, and interpersonal issues, as well as trauma from disasters.



Dr. Shyam H. R. is an Assistant Professor and RCI registered Clinical Psychologist in GFGCW K R Pete. He has been practicing for the past 10 years. He will be conducting Workshop on psychotraumatology.

Ms Nithya H M is Assistant Professor and RCI registered Clinical Psychologist in Chengalpattu Medical College and Hospital Chengalpattu, Chennai TN. She has been practicing for the past 20 years and is an expert in EMDR.
