The United States-India Educational Foundation (USIEF) is pleased to invite applications for Fulbright Fellowships 2026-2027. These fellowships are designed to enhance academic and professional expertise, promote cross-cultural exchange, and build lasting relationships between India and the United States. Please note that deadlines and requirements vary for each fellowship.

Fulbright Specialist Program for Indian Institutions: The Fulbright Specialist Program provides an opportunity for Indian universities and institutions of higher learning to host U.S. experts for short-term durations (two to six weeks) under the Fulbright Specialist Program. The program covers international airfare and provides an honorarium to the Specialist. Hubert H. The program is designed to meet the requirements of policymakers, planners, administrators, and managers in the government, public and private sectors, and non-governmental organizations, who have a public service commitment, demonstrated leadership potential, and committed to their own country's development. **To be announced in April 2025.**

Fulbright Foreign Language Teaching Assistant (FLTA) Program: This is a nine-month, non-degree program which invites applications from early career English teachers teaching at college level or training to become a teacher of English, or a young professional in related fields (e.g., American Studies, American/English Literature, etc.). Selected FLTAs from India will teach Hindi or Urdu at select U.S. campuses. **To be announced in March 2025.**
