Ph.D. THESIS

Title: "Effectiveness of Life Skills Training on Emotional Distress, Problem Behavior, and Social Competence among Adolescent Students."

The research, which used a pre- and post-test experimental design, primarily focused on identifying and helping adolescent students experiencing high emotional distress, problematic behavior, and low social skills. From the selected sample of 160 adolescents (80 boys and 80 girls), those in the experimental group received training in six life skills (problem-solving, decision-making, communication, interpersonal skills, emotional coping, and stress management) out of the ten life skills outlined by WHO. The intervention included 10 sessions, held twice a week over 10 weeks, using an activity-based module created by the researcher. Post-test results showed significant improvements in the experimental group compared to the wait-list control group. The study demonstrates the effectiveness of life skills training in reducing emotional distress and problematic behavior while improving social competence among adolescent students.

The entire research study was completed within three years from the date of registration.
