NOTIFICATION Ph.D ENTRANCE EXAMINATION 2020-21

Applications are invited from Indian Nationals for Ph.D Entrance Examination 2019-20 of the University of Mysore for available seats in various disciplines. List of subjects is available on the website of the University of Mysore. It should be noted that appearing and completion of entrance examination implies only the eligibility of a candidate for admission to Ph.D degree program of the University, but shall not guarantee admission to any Ph.D Degree program of the University. Details are provided in the Ph.D Regulations-2017. (See the website <u>http://uni-mysore.ac.in</u>)

Interested and eligible candidates may apply through online mode. The candidates should check their eligibility exemptions (Section-B) before applying through online mode in the website <u>http://uni-mysore.ac.in.</u> The application form is available on the website from 18/02/2020 to 16/03/2020.

The dates of Entrance Examination will be notified on website of the University. All the examinations will be conducted in **Mysuru** centre only. For further details (including the syllabus for the Entrance Examination) the candidates are advised to visit http://uni-mysore.ac.in

A. Conditions of Eligibility:

- 1. Candidates who have secured at least, a) 55% of aggregate marks for General Merit candidates b) 50% for OBC candidates and c) 45% for SC/ST/Cat-1/PC/transgender, in their Master's Degree or equivalent examination from the recognized Universities/Institutions (See section No.5 in page No.4 in the Ph.D Regulation 2017.) are eligible to apply.
- 2. The candidates should satisfy the other eligibility conditions that are stipulated in the regulations.
- 3. Candidates who are currently pursuing their Master's Degree at Final Year, may also apply.

B. Exemptions:

The candidates possessing the following are exempted from the Entrance Examination as in Ph.D Regulation 2017, Section 5.9.

 Candidates who have qualified JRF fellowships/Lecturership through UGC/CSIR-NET/DBT-JRF/ICMR-JRF/ICAR/SLET(KSET)GATE and M.Phil are exempted from Entrance test. (For M.Phil- Ref UGC-2016 Notification-3 (3.2) followed.)

Note:

- 1. The candidates who are exempted from the Entrance Examination are required to consult the Guides, Supervisors to obtain the consent acceptance letter to apply for provisional registration.
- 2. RGNF/MANF/Project fellows are not exempted from Ph.D Entrance Examination.

C. Syllabus and question paper pattern for Ph.D Entrance Examination:

The prescribed syllabus for the Entrance examination is available subject-wise at www.uni-mysore.ac.in. The question papers for all subjects contain 2 parts.

Part-A: Contains 50 objective type questions of one Mark each.

Part-B: Contains Essay type/short answer questions for 50 Marks. Duration of the examination will be 3(three) hours. Both part-A and part-B put together are evaluated for 100 marks.

D. Procedure to apply online:

The procedure is provided in the website: <u>http://uni-mysore.ac.in</u>. Candidates are expected to fill the application online, pay the application fee and upload the completed application form online.

E. Application fee:

The following are the prescribed fees for Ph.D entrance tests.

- a) General Merit candidates Rs. 1000/- per subject.
- b) SC/ST/Cat-1/PC/transgender candidates Rs. 400/- per subject.

Note:

- 1. Candidates are allowed to apply for only two subjects.
- 2. Payment of fee should be made through Online mode only.

F. General Instructions:

- 1. There is no upper age limit to apply for the Ph.D Entrance examination.
- 2. Foreign Nationals with Indian/Foreign degrees have to contact the Director, International Centre, University College of Fine Arts premises, Manasagangotri, Mysuru-570006, and can submit their applications for admission to Ph.D Degree directly. These candidates are expected to follow the overseas student's admission norms (for Eg. - Equivalence certificates, award of scholarships from host country etc.,) in addition to the norms of 2017 Ph.D Regulations of the University of Mysore.
