The library building measuring 1,15,000 sq feet in floor area with 1500 seating capacity was formally declared opened in 1965 by Dr. S. Radhakrishnan who was then the President of India. 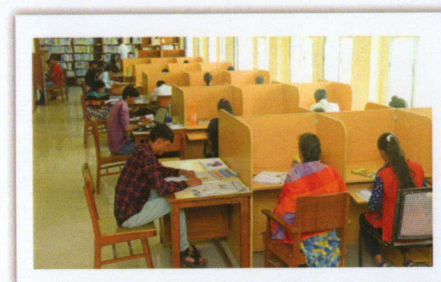
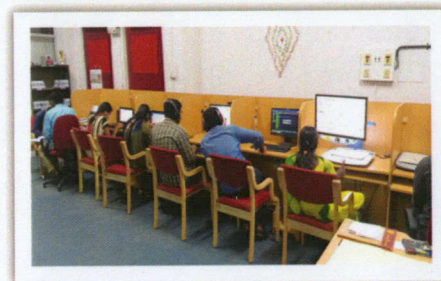

## Reading Hall Facility

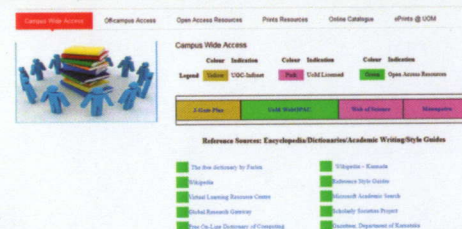
University Library has extended reading hall facility for the benefit of students who can carry their own reading books to the reading



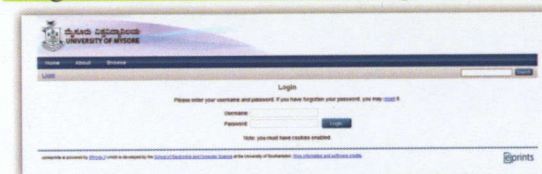

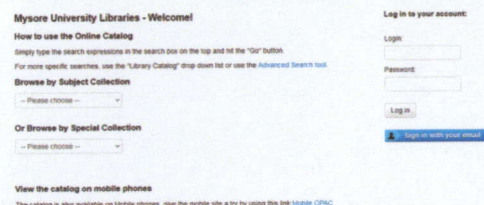
