As per the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes student strength in the University hostels (UG and PG students about 2700) Director of Students Welfare approaches Deputy Registrar, SC-ST Cell to issue the mess amount of Rs. 1500/- per student. By AC bill the same amount will be drawn from the Finance Officer, University of Mysore (GRA Grants).
