



The Chairman welcomed the members of newly constituted Board Of Studies in Ambedkar Studies (UG) and placed before them the agenda of framing the syllabus on Ambedkar studies as a core course to be taught at under graduate from the coming academic year 2020-21. The board thoroughly examined the purpose and utility of the core course and deliberated at length on various components of Ambedkar studies. The board prepared the rough draft and felt the necessity of meeting again on 29th Sunday 2019 to finalize the draft of the syllabus.

Accordingly on Sunday the 29th, 2019 the board met and after a long discussion it scrutinized and approved the syllabus. The Board resolved the following criteria for the implementation of the Ambedkar studies as one of the core courses in under graduation programme.

1) The teachers who have the knowledge on Ambedkar studies are only eligible to

teach and evaluate ²) Ambedkar studies as a core course shall be with two other core courses of arts and Humanities.

3) The Scheme of the Course and Panel of the examiners were prepared and approved.
