


- 1) The teachers who have the knowledge on Ambedkar studies are only eligible to teach and evaluate

- 3) The Scheme of the Course and Panel of the examiners were prepared and approved.



## UG BOS IN AMBEDKAR STUDIES

### SYLLABUS AND EXAMINATION PATTERN

To introduce the whole 100 marks paper of each semester. Out of which 80 marks are for a written examination, to be conducted by the University at the end of each semester and the remaining 20 marks are for Internal assessment.

To award the 20 Marks, reserved for Internal Assessment, based on the performance in Test / Assignment / Seminar / Viva Voce / Field Visit. This is to be done by means of C1 and C2, each for 10 Marks, as follows,

Assessment for Maximum 100 Marks in each Semester

To introduce a Question Paper for 80 Marks Theory Examination, consisting of Part-A and Part-B. Part A is to have Eight Questions, each carrying Ten marks and only Five Questions have to be answered. Part B is to have Four Questions of Fifteen Marks each and only Two Questions have to be answered. The duration of Examination is three hours. The following is the Model of QP.
