Calculation of API Score: The actual hours spent for the academic year is considered for each category Ia, Ib and Ic.

To calculate the API score for category Ia the actual hours spent is divided by a factor of 7.5 for Assistant Professor and 7.75 for Associate professor and Professor.

To calculate the API score for category Ib and Ic the actual hours spent is divided by a factor of 10 for Assistant Professor, Associate professor and Professor.

Note: Calculation of API Score: The actual hours spent for the academic year is considered for each category IIa, IIb and IIc. and shall be supported by the relevant letters / certificates / orders. Any one day event is considered as 8 hours.

To calculate the API score for category IIa, IIb and IIc. the actual hours spent is divided by a factor of 10 for Assistant Professor, Associate professor and Professor.

Example for score calculation: 15 score means 15 hours of teaching per academic year.

#API score is calculated by dividing the actual score by 10 which is 1.5 API score.

Wherever relevant to any specific discipline, the API score for paper in refereed journal would be augmented as follows: (i) paper with impact factor less than 1 - by 5 points; (ii) papers with impact factor between 1 and 2 by 10 points; (iii) papers with impact factor between 2 and 5 by 15 points; (iv) papers with impact factor between 5 and 10 by 20 points: (v) papers with impact factor above 10 by 25 points. The API for joint publications shall be calculated in the following manner: Of the total score for the relevant category of publication by the concerned teacher, the First and Principal / corresponding author /supervisor / mentor would share equally 70% of the total points and the remaining 30% would be shared equally by all other authors.
