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BACKGROUND OF THE WORKSHOP

Research is an essential and powerful tool leading man towards progress. Without systematic research there would have been very little progress. John W. Best has rightly said “The secret of our cultural development has been research, pushing back the areas of ignorance by discovering new truths, which in turn, lead to better ways of doing things and better products. Scientific research leads to progress in some field of life. New products, new facts, new concepts and new ways of doing 2 things are being found due to ever increasing significant research in the physical, the biological, the social and the psychological fields. Research today is no longer confined to the science laboratory. The manufacturers, the agricultural experts and the archeologists are carrying on research in their respective spheres, besides, the sociologists, anthropologists, economists and educationists

Various reports have understood that many of the Ph.D students in social sciences are poorly familiar with scientific methodological courses and lack mastery of vital competencies in research in social sciences. This has resulted in weak examination and analyses of societal challenges and opportunities confronting India, ignore or misapplication of methods and poor connection to theories/models, including meager quality of doctoral research outputs in certain disciplines Also it is found that many of the universities in India are not adequately equipping their Ph.D students with the methodological issues. with this background the current training programme has been arranged to train our young research scholars in a more scientific way.

OBJECTIVES OF THE WORKSHOP

1. To sensitize the new research scholars from the social sciences and humanities background about the significance of research in their field.
2. To Prepare the young scholars and researchers with desired knowledge and skills for conducting basic and advanced scientific research in Social Sciences.
3. To disseminate knowledge about procedure and application of statistical packages such as SPSS and NUD*ISD data base etc
4. To educate, develop and renew the participants with the most recent knowledge and techniques available in the new multidisciplinary Social Science research

2. Literature review formulating research questions and hypotheses
3. Quantitative and qualitative research methods in social sciences

6. Coding, analysis and interpretation,
