Under the NQRI, NAAC has been helping HEI's in the quality assurance process to have positive impetus in raising the quality of HEIs in India. The focus of this workshop will be to popularize and promote quality assurance in higher education. As you are aware, failure to get NAAC accreditation may lead to discontinuation of financial assistance by the UGC to such Universities/Colleges/Institutions.

In view of the above, the IQAC of University of Mysore has taken the initiative to conduct a Two-Day NAAC awareness workshop for non-accredited colleges affiliated to this University.

OUR UNIVERSITY

Came into existence on 27th July 1916, the University of Mysore is one of the oldest Universities in India, and is celebrating its centenary this year. It is the sixth University in the country and the very first in the erstwhile princely state of Mysore. Sri Krishnaraja Wodeyar-IV, the benevolent ruler of Mysore and Sir M. Visvesvaraya, Engineer-Statesman, the then Dewan of Mysore were the pioneers in establishing this University.

Soon after the first NAAC assessment and accreditation, the IQAC was established in the University in 2001. The IQAC was established following the guidelines of the UGC and the NAAC, and with a view to monitor, improve and ensure quality of the entire academic and administrative programmes of the University. The IQAC has evolved appropriate mechanism and procedure to ensure efficient, effective and progressive performance of academic and administrative tasks; ensuring relevance and quality of the academic programmes; maximizing teaching, learning, research, extension and consultancy opportunities; credibility of evaluation procedures, adequacy and maintenance of support structure and services.

INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL

Internal Quality Assurance Cell was established as per NAAC guide lines with the following objectives:

- To develop a system for conscious and consistent action to improve the academic and administrative performance of the institution.
- To promote measures for institutional functioning towards quality enhancement through internalization of quality culture and institutionalization of innovations and best practices.
- To evaluate academic programmes and faculty by students and other stake holders.
- To organize workshops/seminars/meetings etc. to promote quality initiatives.
