However, if they wish to supervise candidates in other disciplines/ interdisciplinary subjects, then they have to formally apply for such recognition as prescribed in 4.1(d).	Colleges affiliated to University of Mysore. <b>4.1</b> (a) Professors or Scientists of equivalent cadre working on regular basis in Departments of Studies of the University/Recognized Research Centers of the University are recognized as Ph.D. Guides in their concerned subjects, by virtue of their positions. The university shall constitute separate BOS for interdisciplinary subjects under the chairmanship of Deans of concerned faculty(ies) depending upon the requirement. Those who would like to become guides with a national level fellowship awards wherein they are allowed to guide candidates as per the guidelines of finding agencies and duration of the fellowship is for a short period. They may be do so as co- guides by registering the candidates under the permanent and regular guide of the subject of the university which is essential as per UGC norms.
5.9 Candidates who have qualified JRF fellowships/ lecturership through UGC/CSIR- NET/DBT-JRF/ICMR-JRF/ICAR Examinations/ SLET (KSET)/ GATE are exempted from Entrance test. Candidates, who have completed M. Phil course/who have joined M.Phil. course are also exempted from the entrance test provided the M.Phil /Equivalent course was through an entrance examination. However all such candidates have to undergo an interview before the probable guide(s) and obtain the consent/acceptance letter from the guide, if vacancies are available.	5.9 Candidates who have qualified JRF fellowships/ lecturership through UGC/CSIR- NET/DBT-JRF/ICMR-JRF/ICAR Examinations/ SLET (KSET)/ GATE/M.Phil are exempted from Entrance test.
