The CBCS Core Committee Meeting held on 15-07-2014 has proposed minor modification to the existing CBCS-CAGP Regulation Section 5.1 and 6.5 Pertaining to re-registration for the P.G students who are compelled to Drop / opt Drop/ Blank semester and pertaining to MAKEUP-DROP. These changes shall be effective for the first semester students of the academic year 2014-15 and onwards.

1. Regarding the re-registration of the courses by the students who are compelled to Drop / opt Drop/ Blank semester.

Section 5.1 of the regulation reads as follows-

Whenever a candidate opts for blank semester(s), he/she has to study-the prevailing courses offered by the department when he/she continues his/her studies.

To be more explicit, it is recommended to re-phrase this part of the regulation 5.1, as follows-

Whenever a candidate opts for blank semester(s)/DROPs of a course or is compelled to DROP a course as per the provision of the regulation, he/she has to study the prevailing courses offered by the department—as per the prevailing scheme, when he/she continues his/her study.

2. Regard to provision/modified provision for MAKE UP in section 6.5 of regulation

Provided a candidate satisfies the attendance requirement and (C1+C2) requirement he/she is allowed to appear for C3. However, if he/she does not clear C3, the candidate is permitted to opt for DROP or take MAKE UP option. Conducting MAKE UP examination as per the present provision for a very very small percentage of students has been taxing the University from many perspectives.

Accordingly it is recommended to slightly modify the last paragraph in section 6.5 as follows-

A MAKE UP examination for odd semester courses will be conducted along with next regular odd semester examinations and for even semester courses along with a next regular even semester examination. If a candidate is still unsuccessful, he/she may opt for DROP or again take up MAKE UP examination; however, not exceeding double the duration norm in one stretch from the date of joining the course.
