01 Preamble

Indian Academy of Social Sciences (ISSA) **in association** with University of Mysore shall hold the 40th session of Indian Social Science Congress between December 19-23, 2016 with a view to discovering, developing and disseminating **science of Nature-Humans-Society** capable of improving material, social, cultural and spiritual life of people of India in particular, and people of the world in general through critical appraisal and integration of scientific knowledge being produced in universities, colleges, research institutes, national and regional laboratories.

02 Focal Theme

The Indian Academy of Social Sciences and University of Mysore have resolved to focus the deliberations of XL Indian Social Science Congress on **‘Peoples Health and Quality of Life in Democratic Republic of India’** with a view to assessing the impact of post-independence development and the problems arising thereof, so as to be able to discover their solutions /ramifications. The deliberations shall also cover the **‘Peoples Health And Quality of Life in Afro-Asian, Latin American, Europeans and American countries’**.

03 International Symposia

It is proposed to hold international symposia on **‘Science and the world Today’ and Peoples Health and Quality of Life in Afro-Asian, Latin American, European and American countries** during the 40th Indian Social Science Congress, with a view to appraising existing connections/linkages between Science and the real world and carve out a new path for science-based world of the future the hunger-free, disease-free, poverty-free, environmental pollution-free, violence-free and ecologically sustainable world.

04 National Seminars/Symposia/Colloquia/Workshops

It is proposed to hold national seminars/symposia/colloquia/ workshop on following themes:

06. Ad Hoc Group Discussion

There is a provision for holding **ad hoc group discussion** on emerging issues of theoretical and methodological significance during the Congress. Anyone or a group of scientists who is/are engaged in doing research on such issues which in their views are of greater theoretical and methodological significance are hereby invited to submit their proposals to the General Secretary, Indian Academy of Social Sciences latest by May 31, 2016.

07. Submission of Papers

Papers can be submitted either in Hindi or in English. Those who do not know either of these languages and wish to present their research papers in any other Indian language are welcome to submit their **original paper in any Indian language along with its translated copy in Hindi or English.**

One is required to submit three copies of one's paper along with its abstract and CD to the General Secretary of Indian Academy of Social Sciences. The length of the abstract should be within 500 words and that of the full paper within 7000 words.

08. Dates of Submission of Papers

August 15, 2016 is the last date for submission of abstract of papers. The last date for Submission of full paper is **September 30, 2016.** The papers can be submitted even after the last date till November 30, 2016, but such papers will be printed only after the Congress is over. Processing is easier if the full paper along with abstract is submitted.

09. Registration

All those who wish to contribute to and participate in XL Indian Social Science Congress are requested to register themselves **before October 31, 2016.** Details of registration can be had from the General Secretary of Indian Academy of Social Sciences or the Local Organising Secretary of XL Indian Social Science Congress and University of Mysore.

All the registered delegates shall be provided free accommodation, local transport, food and literature with kits. However, the registered delegates staying in Hotels will have to make the transport arrangement on their own.

10. Gold Medals

Gold medals are awarded for two best papers presented at the Indian Social Science Congress.
