#### GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The south zone Inter University Cricket (Men) Tournament is scheduled to be held from 28.11.2019 to 11.12.2019 at Department of Physical Education, Sports Pavilion, University of Mysore, Mysuru.
- 2. The Distance from Mysore railway station to Department of Physical Education, Sports Pavilion, University of Mysore is 2.5 k.m. and from Mysore Bus Stand 4 k.m.
  - 3. The distance from Karnataka State Open University, Manasagangothri (where accommodation is arranged) to Bus Stand is 6 k.m and from Railway station 4 k.ms
  - 4. Unfurnished accommodation will be provided to teams at Karnataka State Open University, Manasagangothri, Mysuru and Department of Physical Education, Sports Pavilion, University of Mysore. Teams should bring their own bedding, locks, keys etc.
  - 5. Accommodation will be provided one day prior to their first match and teams should vacate the accommodation within 24hrs after their last match is over.
  - 6. A caution deposit of Rs. 2000/- has to be deposited by the team Manager with the organizing secretary and the same will be refunded after adjustment of cost of damages, if any.
  - 7. Team Manager's meeting will be held at the Department of Physical Education Sports Pavilion, University of Mysore on 27.11.2019 at 3 p.m. The team Managers are requested to attend this meeting and hand over the eligibility proformae to the organizers.
  - 8. Team Managers should bring four copies of the Eligibility performa of the players duly typed and signed by the Registrar/Director of Physical Education/Sports officer of the Participating University along with the player's identity cards and all the students should produce photo copy of +2 examination, Date of Birth certificate and in case of PG students, the pass certificate of the Degree course, duly attested by Director of Physical Education/ Secretary Sports Board/Council/Sports officer/Registrar of the concerned university along with their eligibility certificate and a copy of subscription receipt obtained from AIU, New Delhi should be handed over to the organizing secretary at the time of registration.
  - 9. Inauguration of South Zone Inter University Cricket Men Tournament 2019-20 will be held on **November 27**th **2019 at Maharaja's College Ground at 5.00.pm. at Sports Pavilion premises.** All the teams whose matches are scheduled to be held on November 28th 2019 are requested to attend the Inaugural Function with their University Flags (Mandatory).
  - 10. The Matches will be played on Matting and Turf Grounds.
  - 11. The climate in Mysore during November and December is quite pleasant
  - 12. **Officiating charges of Rs. 1,500/- per team** per match will have to be paid by the Manager of participating University to the organizing secretary.

- 13. Decision of the Tournament committee on all matters relating to the Tournament shall be final and binding on teams.
- 14.0rganizing secretary reserves the right to make changes of the venue, date and time of the matches and same will be intimated one day in advance.
- 15. Participating Universities are requested to inform their arrival, date, time, train name and train number to the organizing secretary well in advance to make necessary arrangements.
- 17. Teams should report at least 30 minutes before the commencement of their match.
- 18. Smoking & Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages are strictly prohibited in the campus and if anyone is found indulged in the above, they will be sent out from the hostel/campus and their accommodation will be cancelled. During the tournament, all the visiting team players must be in the campus before 9.30 pm.
- 19. All the matches up to pre-Quarterfinals shall be of 30 overs a side, from Quarterfinals onwards the matches will be of 45 overs a side.
- 20. For the matches balls will be provided on payment of Rs. 850=00 by the Organizing Secretary and these balls alone will be permitted for the matches.
- 21. The number of overs of Matches could be reduced or curtailed, in case of rain/any other unavoidable situations. The same will be under the sole discretion of the match Referee/on field Umpires.
- 22. Teams should produce their players 'ID's whenever asked for.
- 23. The defaulting University for having not paid the subscription to AIU for the year 2019-20 will not be allowed to participate in this Tournament as per the circular of AIU, the onus of producing the document of payment done to AIU will be on the participating teams.

24. The Team managers are totally responsible for the player's discipline during matches and stay.

### SOUTH ZONE INTER UNIVERSITY CRICKET TOURNAMENT FOR MEN 2019-20 Organised By Department of Physical Education, University Of Mysore, Mysore PLAYING CONDITIONS

#### 30 OVERS MATCH UP TO QUARTER FINALS STAGE

- 1. Matches are played on Knockout basis. Everyday two matches will be played on each ground.
- 2. Players are requested not to waste the time during the match time.
- 3. All matches will be of one inning per side, each inning being limited to a maximum of 30 overs per side. Minimum 10 Overs constitute a match in case of interrupted games.
- 4. Declaration is not permitted.
- 5. No bowler shall bowl more than 1/5th of overs stipulated for an inning.
- 6. If a Match is delayed or interrupted on account of weather or light condition, overs will be reduced(4mins/over).
- 7. Free hit will be awarded for all types of No ball. During Free Hit, Change of field/fieldsman is not permitted for the same striker.
- 8. At the instance of delivery of ball, there shall be not more than 5 fielders on the leg side, and not more than 2 fielders behind the popping crease on the leg side.
- 9. During Power play overs, a maximum of 2 fielders are allowed to field outside the inner circle and during Non power play overs, a maximum of five fielders are allowed to field outside the inner circle.
- 10. One short pitch delivery per over for a bowler is allowed. Subsequent short pitch deliveries in the same over shall be called 'NO BALL'.
- 11. Hours of Play

Match 1: 8.00 am to 12.20pm Match 2: 1.00pm to 5.20pm

#### 12. RESULT

- a) If minimum time for 10 overs is not available/ not even single ball is bowled then the winner will be decided by 'SPIN OF COIN' in the presence of Umpires.
- b) If an inning of batting second is interrupted and minimum overs (i.e. 10 overs) were not played then also winner will be decided by 'SPIN OF COIN' in the presence of Umpires.
- c) If an inning of batting second was played for minimum overs (i.e. 10 overs) the result will be decided on Net Run rate (For Ex. If batting first Team A has scored 180 runs in stipulated 30 overs(NRR=6.00) Batting second Team B has scored 110 runs in 20 overs(NRR=5.5)then as per NRR Team A wins the match by better Run Rate.
- d) If the match ends in a TIE then the team which has lost less number of wickets will be declared as winner, if that is equal then winner will be decided by 'SPIN OF COIN' in the presence of Umpires.
- 13. Umpire's decision will be final and binding on captains. No appeal/protest against umpire's decision will be entertained.
- 14.Teams have to wear white clothing and shoes(Predominantly White for shoes and external gears)

NOTE: AS THERE ARE TWO MATCHES SCHEDULED PER DAY IN ALL GROUNDS, THE TEAMS ARE REQUESTED TO CO-OPERATE BY STRICTLY REPORTING 30 MINUTES BEFORE SCHEDULE.

#### 45 OVERS MATCH FROM QUARTER FINALS ONWARDS

- 1. Matches are played on Knockout basis..
- 2. Players are requested not to waste the time during the match time.
- 3. All matches will be of one inning per side, each inning being limited to a maximum of 45 overs per team. 20 overs to constitute a match if the game is interrupted due to ground, weather or light condition.
- 4. Declaration is not permitted.
- 5. No bowler shall bowl more than 1/5th of overs stipulated in an inning.
- 6. If a Match is delayed or interrupted on account of weather or light condition, overs will be reduced (4mins/Over)
- 7. Free hit will be awarded for all types of No ball. During Free Hit, Change of field/fieldsman is not permitted for the same striker.
- 8. At the instance of delivery of ball, there shall be not more than 5 fielders on the leg side, and not more than 2 fielders behind the popping crease on the leg side
- 9. During Power play overs a maximum of 2 fielders are allowed to field outside the inner circle and during Non power play overs, a maximum of five fielders are allowed to field outside the inner circle. (Applicable to 45 overs format)
- 10. Two short pitch deliveries per over for a bowler is allowed. Subsequent short pitch deliveries in the same over shall be called 'NO BALL'.




#### 12. RESULT

- a) If minimum time for 20 overs is not available/ not even single ball is bowled then the winner will be decided by 'SPIN OF COIN' in the presence of Umpires.
- b) If an inning of batting second is interrupted and a minimum overs (i.e. 20 overs) is not completed then also winner will be decided by 'SPIN OF COIN' in the presence of Umpires.
- c) If an innings of batting second was played for minimum overs (i.e. 20 overs) the result will be decided on overall run rate (ex. If batting first Team A has scored 270 in stipulated 45 overs(NRR=6.00). Batting second Team B has scored 160 run in 30 overs(NRR=5.33) then Team A wins the match by better Run Rate.
- D) If the match ends in a TIE then the team which has lost less number of wickets will be declared as winner, if that is also equal then winner will be decided by 'SPIN OF COIN' in the presence of Umpires.
- 13. Umpire's decision will be final and binding on captains. No appeal/protest against umpire's decision will be entertained.
- 14. Teams have to wear white clothing and shoes (Predominantly White for shoes and external gears).


# SOUTH ZONE INTER-UNIVERSITY CRICKET (MEN) TOURNAMENT - 2019-20 Fixtures POOL-A




